2023 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Purpose

Requirements for Completion of the Application

The following list of documents must be sent with your completed application. The application, along with all supporting documents, **must be submitted by mail and postmarked by July 15, 2023, 11:59 PM.** Applications will not be accepted after the deadline.

- List any non-academic honors received while in high school or postsecondary educational institutions including career training programs. Also, list any non-academic awards you may have received from a community organization or church.
- Submit two letters of recommendation. Recommendation letters are to be written by any two of the following: a teacher, an administrator, a high school or career technical school counselor, a community organization member, or employer.



3. A typed 500- word essay. The topic of your essay must address the following two-part question:

What are your plans after you graduate? How will the Lancaster Family Scholarship help you reach your desired goals?

Your essay will be evaluated on the following:

- Clarity and organization of your ideas
- Punctuation
- Grammar
- Supportive statements about the topic.
- 4 A non-returnable photocopy of yourself. Only pictures of the two winners will be shared with Lancaster Foundation members.
- 5 Please submit an official current high school transcript. If you are participating in or are going to participate in a career training program, please provide evidence of acceptance or a progress report showing that you are effectively working toward successful completion of the program.
- 6 List any academic honors you may have received. If you are in a career training program, provide academic or other technical school related honors you have received.
- 7 List any non-academic honors received while in high school or post-secondary educational institutions including career training programs. Also, list any non-academic awards you may have received from a community organization or church.
